What Makes a Dad

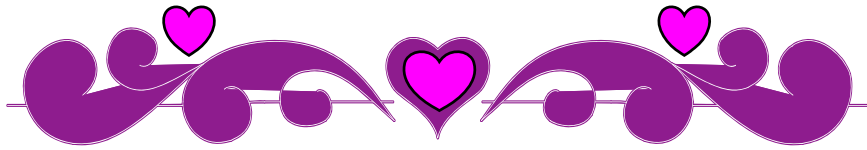
God took the strength of a mountain,

View From the Pulpit

America is free. On June 3, all across this nation, people will go to little booths and press buttons or touch screens to vote for various local officials, and local and state proposals.

Several years ago I worked with a young man from Russia. He was amazed by two things about America. The first was grocery stores: the second was that we change leaders every 4 or 8 years peacefully, without thousands of people dying.

Our grocery stores come from our free market system and our peaceful change of leaders come from the fact that we know we will get a new one in a few years....so if we don't like this one, there is practically a new one on the horizon. Our markets and government are based on free choice and free speech and many other freedoms detailed in the Bill of Rights.

When Paul speaks about freedom in Christ, he is speaking of a freedom that goes much deeper than political freedom or freedom to assemble. He is addressing the fact that Christians are totally accepted by God and have the power to be victorious over sin. So, as Christians, we have the freedom to follow God, worship God and live in the presence of God freely.

This means that Christians can worship God in silence or in song. We can read the NIV or the KJV of the Bible. We can go to church on Sunday or Saturday or any other day we want.

We also have freedom in how we live. We can eat what we want, wear what we want and live where we want, and not have it affect the quality of our relationship with God.

God created us with creativity and varieties of expression. We need to be ourselves, express ourselves and be creative as we live in the presence of God, as we live free.

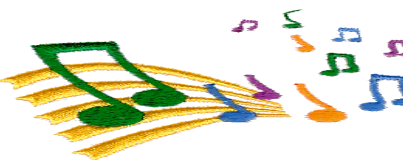
